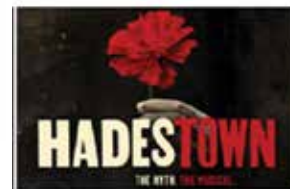


The Fabulous Fox

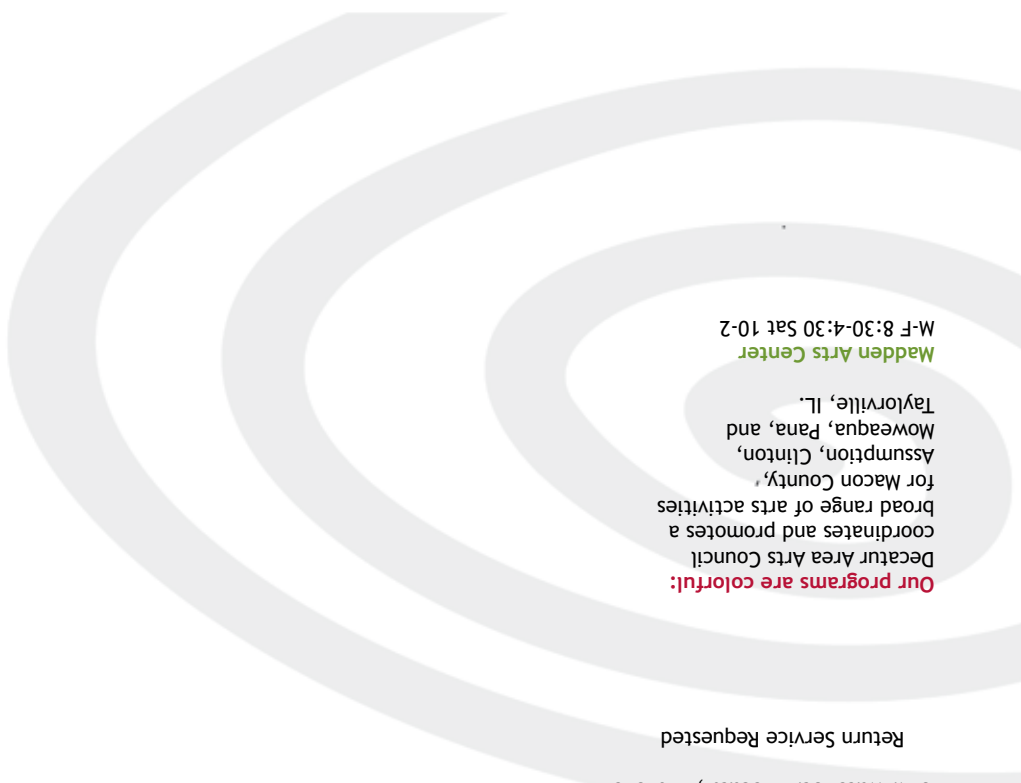
